Do the rights of a user need to be changed? Only a company administrator can do that. You can find this in the same overview in the 'MyGS1' column.

Is there an external party that requires access to your My Product Manager account for data entry purposes? Then you or the company can create a link using an email address. This is because it is only possible to link a single email address to one company.

#### 2.1 Dashboard

The Dashboard contains an overview of your company prefixes. You can also view the number of bar codes available to your company here.

#### 2.2 My products

In the tab 'My Products', you get to see a list of all items which are currently linked to your GLN. **Products** 



- 1) Description: Name of your product.
- 2) GTIN: GTIN of your product.
- 3) Packaging: Packaging level (base unit, outer box, display, ...).
- 4) Brand: Brand of your product.

5) Status: The status of your product sheet. This affects the visibility of your product sheet for data customers. More information per status:

	This status means that the item is still 'in production' and does not yet have a GTIN.

#### 2.6 My actions

If you wish to adjust multiple products in one go, you can go to our Actions-tab. This will allow you to make generate exports and imports through Excel, adjusting multiple items and update data in one take. More information on this functionality, is found in chapter 5.5.



#### 2.7 **Profile-related features**

In My Product Manger there are several features that can be activated or deactivated. Although it is not currently visible in your account, it can be requested from our help desk via <u>support@gs1belu.org</u>

#### Automatic GTIN generator

Have your GTIN generated automatically in MPM when you create your product sheet. That way, you won't have to manage and check whether you are using the correct GTIN.

If you are a new member of GS1, this is activated by default. If you do not want this feature, we can always disable it and you can manage your GTINs yourself.

If you are already a GS1 member and have been preparing GTINs yourself for some time, this is not activated. The reason for this is that we need to know your GTINs and load them into your profile so that there are no duplicate GTINs in circulation. If you wish, you can contact our help desk to arrange this.

#### Entering non-branded/own brand products

If you have to enter products in My Product Manager that do not belong to your brand, it may result in a blocking error message if the GTIN starts with the Belgian country code (X54). This may be the case with regard to private label items, among others.

- If you need to enter Private Label items for Delhaize, please follow the instructions in <u>chapter 5.4</u> in this manual.
- If you need to enter Private Label items for Colruyt, Makro, ..., you should do this in their platforms.
- If you need to enter the products of another company because you are a distributor or other, please contact our help desk (<u>support@gs1belu.org</u>)

#### **GDSN** features

If you need to send product sheets to GDSN customers (Maxeda, Colruyt, Delhaize, Bol.com, **hospitals,** etc.) you will need to have the GDSN feature in your My Product Manager profile. You can identify this by checking whether you see 'GDSN targets' in the 'My Publications' tab. If so, this feature has been activated. If it is not activated, then there may be two reasons for it:

- 1. You indicated you only want to enter label information during your registration, or because you previously had Trustbox only (FMCG food)
- 2. You have not yet subscribed to MPM Share or your application is still being processed.

## 3 What information should I enter?

#### **3.1** Fast Moving Consumer Goods & Foodservice :

'My Product Manager' gives you the option of creating a 'digital twin' of the physical product that you, as a brand owner or distributor, are offering for the FMCG & foodservice sector. Products that belong here are food, care, maintenance or other non-food products that are sold in supermarkets or that are consumed or prepared by a hotel or catering facility.

In the case of **food**, it is important to communicate the **legally required information** on this product, so that the **data consumer and end consumer** receive all the essential information they are entitled to and should be informed about. This will mainly concern the information to be found on the label. When entering product information for consumer units, all the information that can be found on the **label** should also be included in the online version available to the consumer on a **web shop or mobile application**.



Depending on the activated profile in your My Product Manager account, you can enter **logistical information** on your product sheet, regardless of whether it is a food, non-food or near-food item. If **GDSN** is active in your account, you will be able to enter this information.

Information that is legally required, must also to be entered in 'My Product Manager', and is included in the **data model** and the validation rules. You can find it <u>here</u> on our website. You can also find the explanatory document on the data model, in which there is a more detailed explanation of specific topics that are linked to the data model.

Of course, it may also be the case that there is more information available about your product than is shown on the label. The label is of course physically limited in the display of product information, but the online version does not have to be. That **additional information** can be of **practical** use to the consumer so they are better informed about the item they want to buy online, for example, but it can also facilitate searches. For the data consumer, this additional information may also be of interest for improving classification of the product information in, for example, web shops or mobile applications.

This product information, where the applicable attribute is available, can therefore also be entered, even if it is not (yet) on the label.

#### 3.2 Do-it-yourself, garden & pet

In 'My Product Manager' you can create a product sheet in full compliance with the rules of the Do-ityourself, Garden & Animal data model. In the data model there are attributes that apply to every brick (mandatory or not), and there are eCommerce attributes, which only apply to specific bricks (also mandatory or not).

Information which is required to be entered—whether or not it is generally mandatory, or brickspecific required, or required because of a validation rule (due to a dependency in the data model) will always be clearly indicated in the My Product Manager interface. If you follow the instructions, you will always have a product sheet that is complete for the data model.

However, do not forget to check which extra information you wish to provide, because in addition to the compulsory items, there will probably be other data that could be interesting for customers and web shops. The more information, the better!

#### 3.3 Healthcare

In 'My Product Manager' you can create a product sheet in full compliance with the "ECHO" data model. In the data model there are attributes that apply to several countries and the FDA

Information which is required to be entered—whether or not it is generally mandatory, or country required, or required because of a validation rule (due to a dependency in the data model)—will always be clearly indicated in the My Product Manager interface. If you follow the instructions, together with the XIs of the Datamodel you will always have a product sheet that is complete for the data model.

However, do not forget to check which extra information you wish to provide, because in addition to the compulsory items, there will probably be other data that could be interesting for hospitals, pharmacy etc... The more information, the better!

## 4 Before you start

#### 4.1. GS1 terminology

In the table below, you will find the explanation of various terms used in this manual.

Term	Definition
МРМ	My Product Manager Is the interface in which you manage your product sheets. You can enter, update and send information.
GDSN	Global Data Synchronisation Network This is a worldwide network of 45 connected databases, referred to as GS1 GDSN data pools. All these data pools process the product information in the same way. This enables users of the network to exchange standardised product data sheets with each other globally via their local data pool.
Data model	Contains the guidelines on how to fill in the product sheet so that it meets the expectations of your data consumer. The data models are country specific.
Hierarchy	Is the set of items that are related to each other, e.g. jar A is 10x in outer box A. This box is 50x on pallet A.
Validating	Verifies that the product sheet complies with the validation rules arising from the data model. You do this within your product sheet.
Release	By releasing it from within your MPM, you are making your product sheet available in the GDSN network. This is done after validation of your product sheet.
Publication	This is where you indicate who is allowed to receive your released product sheet. You can do this in the tab 'My publications'.

#### 4.2. From creation to publication - an overview

## 5 Creating or updating a product

5.1. Creating a new product



Every user who has access to 'My Product Manager' can upload GTINs based on a **Belgian prefix** of which they are the owner, or based on a **foreign** prefix.

However, if you wish to load products under a Belgian prefix of which you are not the owner (e.g. as a wholesaler), please contact the **Retail help desk** via <u>support@gs1belu.org</u>. As administrators, they are able to modify your account so that it will be possible to load GTINs with any type of prefix, including those of which you are not the owner.

When creating a product, there are two options:

- The product is new and you are starting from scratch. You **don't have a similar product** already in My Product Manager that you can base your product on.
- The product is new, but you can base it on a **similar product** which is already in My Product Manager. Click through to <u>4.1.B</u>
- A. <u>New sheet, without a similar product as basis</u>

All mandatory attributes are shown by means of an error in the sidebar. To see them, just click on "validate" at the bottom of the screen (see Step 5).

When all the error messages have been eliminated, you have completed the minimum mandatory fields. We advise you to also fill in a maximum number of fields in the "product specific" tab. These fields are specific to the product category (GPC) selected and therefore very relevant for the retailer/customer.

For an overview of the manuals that can help you, please see <u>Chapter 5.4.C</u>.

Healthcare

In this tab, you specify the information that is important for your product. For this, the data model and its validation rules provide a guide.

The Healthcare datamodel ECHO is for the moment only valid for 2 GPC codes 10005844 (=Medical Devices) and 10005845 (=Pharmaceutical Drugs) If other GPC codes are used these products fall under Do-it-yourself or FMCGI datamodel.

The easiest way to see all that validations is, after correcting the indicated errors, to then save your file as a draft and validate it (see Step 5). Other validations will become visible. At the moment, not all (conditionally) of the compulsory fields have a validation rule. As a result, we want to provide some more information about the information expected by the data customers. FMCG & Foodservice

In this tab, you specify the information that is important for your product. For this, the data model and its validation rules provide a guide.

-A- Consumer units

#### Label information

When you create a consumer unit, you need to make a 'digital twin' of the physical product. In the case of food, it is important to communicate the legally required information on this product, so that the data consumer and end consumer receives all the essential information they are entitled to and should have. This will mainly concern the information to be found on the label. When entering product information for consumer units, all the information that can be found on the label should also be included in the online version available to the consumer on a web shop or mobile application.

The information you enter in My Product Manager will be an identical copy of the information available on the label.

If you want more information about a particular field, simply select the relevant information



Pack-shots



For each consumer unit, it is mandatory to add a pack-shot. A pack-shot is a front elevation of the product with an angle of view of 0 degrees, as it would be displayed on the shop shelf. In the case of a packaged product, this therefore means the packaging.

#### Logistical information

You must also enter the logistical information for consumer units. This includes the dimensions of your product, the tax information, the availability information of your product, packaging information, certificates, etc.

If you want more information about a particular field, simply select the relevant information icon

-B- Non-consumer units

#### Logistical information

You must also enter the logistical information for non-consumer units. This includes the dimensions of your product, the tax information, the availability dates of your product, packaging information, certificates, etc.

It is not compulsory to fill in label information for non-consumer units (such as ingredients, allergens, nutritional values, etc.) or to add a pack-shot.

-C- Hierarchy (= link between basic unit, outer box, pallet)

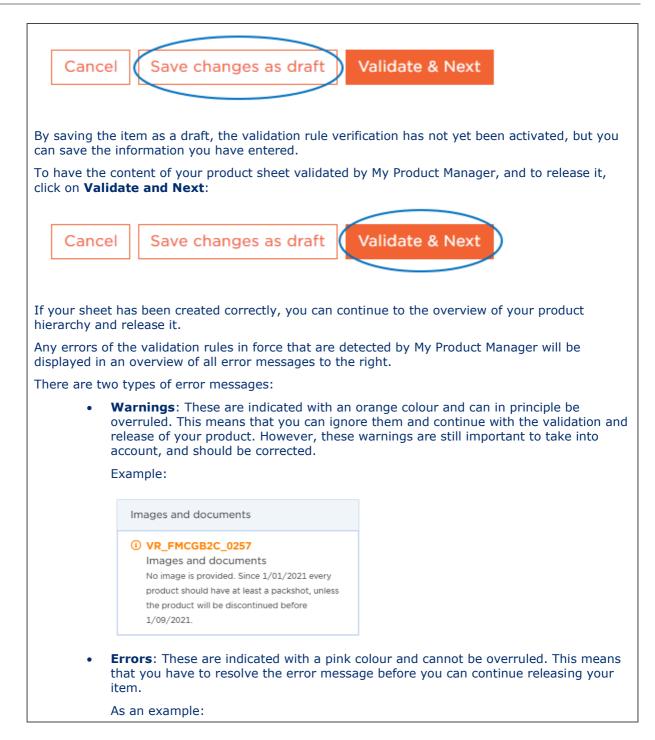
When you have created several items from the same hierarchy, you can link them to each other. You do this in the Hierarchy tab for each item that is **not** the basic unit. You can enter an underlying item in this tab.

In practical terms, this means that you enter your basic unit as the underlying item in your outer carton, and your outer carton as the underlying item in your pallet, etc.

You can also enter several underlying items in one GTIN, such as for a display containing several different basic units.

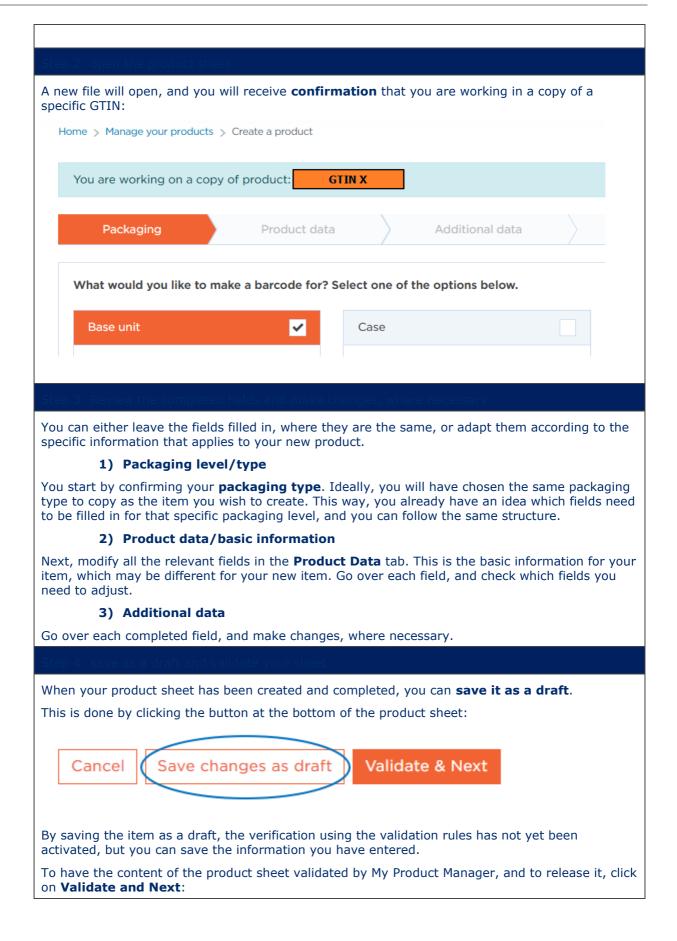

The following pop-up screen will be displayed so you can enter the GTIN of your new item. Fill in the GTIN and click **Confirm**.

The file is now created and available in your product overview.

It is important that the product information entered in My Product Manager fully corresponds to the real product. This information must therefore be identical to the information on the label.

You should therefore do an extra verification of the information in My Product Manager and the information on the label.

Depending on your account settings, you will be able to generate a GTIN or add an existing GTIN when your product sheet is completed.

#### 5.2 Updating an existing product

You may need to update a product data sheet for two reasons:

- i. It contained an error or is missing information.
- ii. You have updated your account with the GDSN feature.

#### A. Correctiong errors

B. If you want to modify the data in an existing sheet, follow these steps.If you have many files to amend, it is best to correct one file and then use our bulk editing feature.

C. Refreshing records after updating profile with GDSN functionality

When activating the GDSN feature in your My Product Manager profile, extra fields become available to enable you to send in a complete product sheet.

You can find these extra fields in your product sheet by simply opening the product sheet. You will notice that some of these fields display an 'error' message. The files will not have a status change at first, but these errors will invalidate them when My Product Manager is updated. It is therefore important to solve all errors in your product sheet as soon as possible.

To do this follow these steps:

Step 1: update one product sheet in the interface

Step 2: use the (*bulk edit*) Excel feature to update all other files.

Attention! Solving the errors alone will not result in a completed product sheet! You will still need to enter extra information to meet the expectations of your data customers.

#### 5.3 Add images and documents

Images and other digital files such as certificates, safety sheets, etc. are uploaded to My Product Manager. These have to be uploaded at the consumer units level in the Pictures and Documents tab.

Do you have a private label article that you need to enter for **Delhaize**?

To create a private label article for Delhaize you need to be a GDSN user.

In these product sheets you only need to enter logistic information (cfr. the fields you enter for nonconsumer units like e.g. a box) even if it is a consumer unit with label information.

To make sure that the validations regarding label information are not triggered, you will have to enter the Delhaize GLN (5400110000009) and the Delhaize contact information in the contact data. You do this in the tab "Contact information" in the following 2 fields:

#### 5.5 Bulk editing

The bulk editing feature enables making adjustments for certain attributes at once and applying the change to multiple files. This can be done using either the web interface or using Excel.

By using the web-interface, you will be able to adjust one or multiple attributes at once, but only applying the same value for all the indicated products to that specific attribute. Each selected article will get the indicated new value by using the bulk edit in the interface. This option is suitable for e.g. attributes that share contact information, which usually remains the same for more/all products, but is not suited for attributes communicating changing nutritional values or allergens, which are usually different for each individual product.

By using the Excel-function, you are able to change or fill in each individual attribute, for each individual product, and upload your changes at once.

Depending on the change you wish to make, you can either chose the first or second option.

#### B. Using Excel

The Excel file will only download fields that are filled in for the sheets you have selected. This is why we recommend always setting up one sheet correctly in the interface so you can use it as an example or reference. Afterwards, you can easily download the created item, along with the other items you wish to adjust, and all the necessary attributes will be present in the file.

#### 1. Select the items that you wish to change

#### 3. Modify data

Every column in the downloaded Excel sheet corresponds to a field that has been filled in in your product sheet. It is therefore important that you use a correct sheet as a reference. Use this as the basis for putting all the information in order. This will help avoid wrong-code errors and similar messages.



Good to know:

- a. Have you created a product sheet for **different target markets**? Then it will be displayed on a single line in the Excel sheet. There will be two (or more) columns showing the target market.
- b. Do you want to **delete data**? To do this, either delete the entire column or empty the data in the column.
- c. You can also create items by entering the necessary data in the first empty line of the file. Attention! You must give these a GTIN. This Excel sheet does not (yet) offer the option of generating GTINs automatically for you (provided that your profile has this function, see 2.). To do that, use the 'Export ID cards' function. More information in <u>Chapter 5.5.C</u>)

#### C. Generating GTIN in bulk (optional)

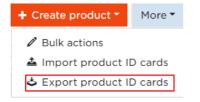
If your account is set up so that My Product Manager generates your GTINs for you, you can generate GTINs in batches if you want to add many products at once.

You can only do this by using the Export and Import of ID cards feature. This Excel file contains a fixed structure that allows you to create the product with **basic data**.<sup>1</sup>.

Please follow these steps:

#### 1. Export the ID cards

To do this, click More and then Export at the top of your product list.



#### Step 2: Enter the data

Enter the basic data for your products, as has been done for the example items in the exported Excel file. Leave column B, where the GTIN is normally placed, empty. This way My Product Manager knows which items it has to create a GTIN for. Use this export file as your template.

Pay attention to the following in the Excel file for *Import ID cards*:

- 1) **Delete** all the products that are already on My Product Manager from the file.
- 2) **Supplier Product ID**: What you enter in this field will only be visible in the Excel export file. It will not be shown in the web interface of My Product Manager.
- GTIN: The GTIN must be 14 digits long (meaning that consumer units must start with 0) and it must be formatted as text. You can do this in Excel simply by starting the GTIN with an apostrophe (').
   If you wish My Product Manager to generate a GTIN for your product, leave this field blank.

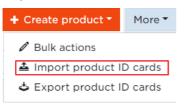

- 4) **Target Markets**: Please enter the three-digit code for your target markets here, separated by a comma. You can find the three-digit code in My Product Manager when you open or create a product and go to the field "In which countries is the product sold?". (e.g. Belgium is "056" and Luxembourg is "442")
- 5) **GPC**: Please enter here the 8-digit code for the brick. A product can only contain one GPC code.
- 6) **Image**: You can upload a URL of your product image here. If your product is not online (and therefore cannot be downloaded via a URL), you cannot enter it in the Excel sheet. In that case, after importing your Excel file, you will have to upload your image manually into your products via the web interface.

#### Step 3. Import the ID cards

Import ID cards: To do this, click More at the top of your product list, and then Import.



Once your Excel file has been imported, it will be checked manually by the Retail Help Desk staff prior to your products appearing in My Product Manager. You will then receive an email to let you know as soon as your products have been added to your account.

## 6 Releasing and publishing a product

#### 6.1 Release

Once your product has been created, and been validated, you will come to the following screen, where you can find your item and other products that it is linked to. This is called a hierarchy.

Before you click Validate and release, you need to check two things:

- Is your hierarchy complete? Click. If it is not, click Cancel and create any missing hierarchy levels.
  - Create
  - Use the 'Hierarchy' tab to link by indicating the underlying unit in the sheet.
- Do **all sheets have a Valid status**? If not, click on the pencil icon of the relevant record. This will take you directly to the record to be validated.

If the above points are correct, you can 'Validate and release' the hierarchy. The hierarchy's logical links will then be verified. If this is correct you will receive a green message indicating that the release was successful.

Is there an error? Then you will receive a red message requesting that you rectify the errors. You can find the error messages by clicking on the warning triangle next to the relevant sheets. A sidebar containing the error message(s) will then be displayed.

After 'Validating and releasing' your selected data customers will receive the product sheet. Do you want to know who they are? Then look in the tab 'My publications'. More information about publications follows.

#### 6.2 Publishing

#### MPM targets & GDSN targets

In the My Publications tab you will see two targets: MPM targets and GSDN targets.

- MPM target: are data customers that use My Product Manager as a platform for receiving data.
- GDSN targets: are data customers that use another platform to receive data. Do you not see these targets, but need to publish to GDSN? Please contact our help desk via <u>support@gs1belu.org</u>.

How do you know which target you have to publish to? Your data customers will tell you. Attention! Some data customers wish to receive the information under both MPM targets and GDSN targets. In the FMCG sector this is the true of Colruyt & Delhaize, among others.

Take note: Once a product hierarchy has been published to a GDSN target, you will no longer be able to change the hierarchy. If you want to do so, you first have to de-publish your product hierarchy (= empty the GDSN targets of your product hierarchy in My Publications).

• Publishing

In order to publish correctly, please follow the next steps:

#### Step 1: Where does the data customer want to receive the data?

Ask your data customer where they want to receive the information: in MPM, GDSN or both?

#### Step 2: View your MPM publications (MPM targets)

Every product sheet with a valid status is automatically visible to an MPM data customer. Would you like a particular sheet to be invisible or all your sheets to be invisible for a specific MPM data customer? Then go to the Opt-out Procedure (*Chapter 6.2.C*).

Pay attention to foodstuffs (FMCG food)! Depending on the profile of your MPM customer, the visibility of your product data sheet for them will also depend on whether or not it is a consumer or food service item.

Have you created a food product and is your MPM data customer Fooddesk, Colruyt, Delhaize, Bidfood or Lambrechts? It is possible that they will not see your data sheet because it is not a consumer unit/food service item.

#### Step 3: View your GDSN publications (GDSN targets)



If your data customer wishes to receive the product sheet via GDSN, you can arrange this using GDSN targets.

The default setting for GDSN targets is 'not published'. You have to **<u>publish them yourself from</u> <u>the highest level of your hierarchy</u>**.

The sheets of the underlying units will automatically be sent with them.

The publications can be done in two different ways:

Target-market specific	GLN specific
= to everyone in the selected target market	= only to the GLNs you enter.
To do this, select the 'Yes' setting. You will then see the status 'Public'.	To do this, use the setting 'No' and enter the GLNs per row. You can ask your retailer/data customer for the GLN.
The advantage of this is that you only have to publish once.	The advantage of this is that you know precisely what data you will receive.
	If you publish <b>private label</b> items for <b>Delhaize</b> , it's this way you need to publish the productsheet to GLN 5400110000009.

Take note: Once a product hierarchy is published to a GDSN target, you may no longer modify the hierarchy (disconnect an item or modify quantities).

#### • Opt-out procedure for MPM targets

By default, a product sheet with a valid status is visible to all MPM data customers. You can change the **default settings** using 'Default publication settings for new products'. If you still have a product that requires a **specific publication setting** in MPM, you can arrange this using 'Overview publication settings per product'.

#### The Default setting

It is important to set this to `**Yes**' if you want your product information to be available and visible to all customers.

The product information is public and may be sent to all known data recipients connected to My Product Manager.



If you wish, it is also possible to specifically indicate that your product information is only sent to one or more specific data customers, instead of all registered data customers. You do this by indicating "No", and then specifying which customers are to receive your product information.

When "No" is indicated, two columns are displayed. The customers in the right-hand column are the ones who will receive your product information.

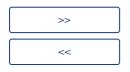

## 7 Removing or de-publishing a product

#### 7.1. Removing

Once a product has been given a GTIN, you cannot delete it. The reason for this is that GTINs may not be reused. Products with a GTIN that are no longer sold should not be deleted but de-published.

In some exceptional cases, your products might need to be removed (for example, if your product was accidentally created with the wrong GTIN in My Product Manager). In such cases you can contact our help desk via <u>support@gs1belu.org</u>.

#### 7.2. De-publishing

To publish a product, the following steps must be followed:

- Open your product sheet
- Go to the Timings tab

- 7. Complete the same process for all the other sheets in the hierarchy.
- 8. Validate and release the full hierarchy
- 9. Wait approximately 30 minutes
- 10. Go to My Publications and de-publish your items
- 11. After the expiry of the Date/time production ends, your file will automatically receive a Stopped status.
